

1. In June 2006 England completed a three match series against Sri Lanka.
Each side won one test match with one match drawn.
Calculate the series points earned for each side for the series.

2. In May 2006 South Africa played new Zealand in a three match series.
South Africa won the series 2 - 0 with one match drawn.
Calculate the series points earned for each side for the series.

3. During the summer of 2006 England hosted Pakistan in a four match test series.
England won the series 3 matches to 0, with one drawn match.
Before the series England's rating was 113 and Pakistan's rating was 120.
Calculate the number of rating points that each side gained during the series.

Beginning in November 2006, England will defend the Ashes in Australia in a five match test series. Before the start of the test series their respective Championship entries were

1. Calculate the number of rating points that each side will gain during the series if:
 - a) England win the series 3 - 1, with one drawn match
 - b) The series is tied 2 - 2.
